# Haftarah for Shabbat Chukkat 2 Kings 18:1-8

What happened to the copper serpent of the Torah portion? By the Seventh Century BCE it had itself become an object of worship. In our haftarah, it, along with other places of idol worship were destroyed by King Hezekiah.

In the third year of Hoshea son of Elah, king of Israel, Hezekiah the son of Ahaz, king of Judah, began to reign.

He was twenty- five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned twentynine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name was Abi the daughter of Zechariah. And he did what was right in the eyes of the Eternal, according to all that David his father had done.

He removed the high places and broke the pillars and cut down the Asherah. And he broke in pieces the copper serpent that Moses had made, for until those days the people of Israel had made offerings to it (it was called Nehushtan).

He trusted in the Eternal, the God of Israel, so that there was none like him among all the kings of Judah after him, nor among those who were before him. For he held fast to the Eternal. He did not depart from following him, but kept the commandments that the Eternal commanded Moses.

And the Eternal was with him; wherever he went out, he prospered. He rebelled against the king of Assyria and would not serve him.

He struck down the Philistines as far as Gaza and its territory, from watchtower to fortified city.
