# Pray with us

Erev Shabbat Service Fridays 7, 14, 21, 28 September, 18:30-19:30

We begin Shabbat with our uplifting and inspirational, intergenerational Erev Shabbat service. A unique combination of song, reflection, prayer & learning, often with guitar & occasionally a band.

#### **Shabbat Morning Services**
