Erev Shabbat Service (*Fridays 1, 8, 15, 22 February, 18:30-19:30*)

We begin Shabbat with our uplifting and inspirational, intergenerational Erev Shabbat service. A unique combination of song, reflection, prayer & learning.

Shabbat Morning Services

Jews don't do art – or do they?

One of the first things the early Zionists did was to establish a school of art in Jerusalem (1906) naming it 'Bezalel.' He was the man appointed by Moses to oversee the construction of the Tabernacle in the desert, about which we read in the Torah last Shabbat. Is a 'Jewish Art School' a contradiction in terms, violating the tradition which argues that it was against the Torah for Jews to 'do' art? Is there any substance at all to that tradition? Explore these questions with Rabbi Colin, looking at many examples, ancient and modern.
