Erev Shabbat Service

(Fridays 6, 13, 20, 27 September, 18:30-19:30)

We begin Shabbat with our uplifting and inspirational, intergenerational Erev Shabbat service. A unique combination of song, reflection, prayer & learning.

Shabbat Morning Services

Hersh, now a rabbi, survived Auschwitz with his faith strengthened; Chaim escaped the Nazis, but had lost his faith long before. The two argue about their Judaism, their survival – and their quarrel.

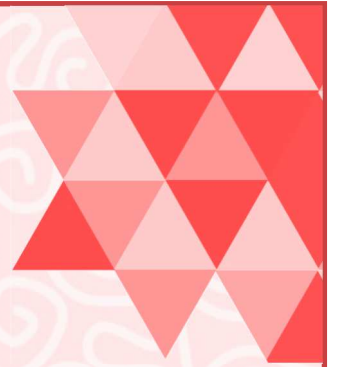

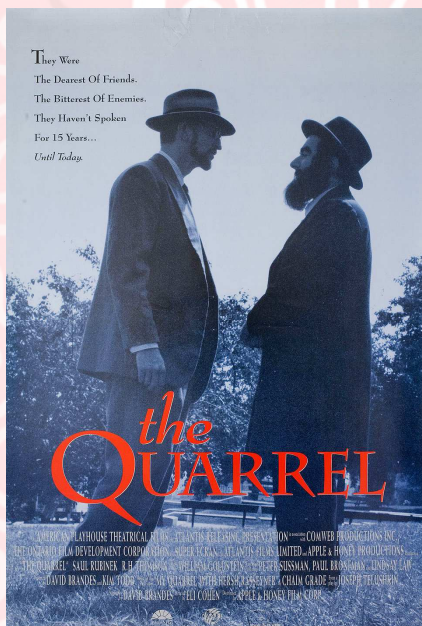
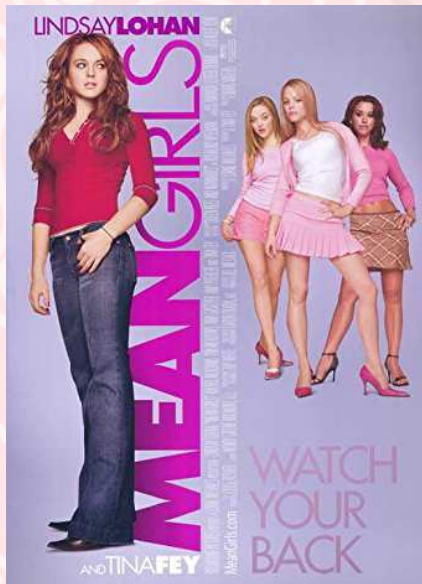
