Transforming Tefillah in Solomon's Temple

The traditional haftarah when the portions of Vayakhel and Pekudey are combined details the construction and consecration of Solomon's Temple. The moment is marked by the king with a spontaneous prayer, beginning the spiritual centrality of the Jerusalem Temple in Israelite religion. Join Rabbi Dr Charles Middleburgh, Dean and Director of Jewish Studies at the Leo Baeck College, to look at four related texts from the Tanakh and consider the important relationship between prayer and place.

Alyth Film Club: The Shop on the High Street (1965) Tuesday 10 March, 19:30-22:00

Antonin Tono Brtko is a poor carpenter appointed by his Nazi brother-in-law to be 'Aryan controller' of an old Jewish widow's sewing shop in a Nazi-occupied Slovakian town in 1942. The widow, Rozalie, is near deaf, isolated and partially sighted. Barely even registering there is a war going on, she fails to fully realize the implications of the context in which she lives. Believing Tono is simply her new assistant, the two develop a tentative friendship that sees him maintaining that fiction as he attempts to protect her from the encroaching Nazi horror.
