To collect the resources needed to run your own tashlich, you will need to find members of the Alyth team hiding around the Heath Extension (they will be there between 15:00 and 17:00). The route should take no more than 45 minutes and will end with the opportunity to run your own tashlich, with a member of the Alyth team there to support you.
