IF YOU ARE COMING OUT TO MEET THE ALYTH BUS, PLEASE REMEMBER THE RULE OF SIX IF YOU SEE OTHER ALYTH MEMBERS.

From Alyth we will drive along the Finchley Road turning right onto Hoop Lane

Along Hoop Lane to Armitage Road Turning left onto Woodstock Road Turning right onto Hodford Road Turning left onto Dunstan Road

Along Dunstan Road to West Heath Avenue

Up West Heath Avenue (approx. 9:15)

Turning right onto North End Road

Turning left onto Wellgarth Road
Turning left onto Hampstead Way

Turning right onto Meadway

Along Meadway to Holne Chase

Turning left onto Winnington Road

Turning right onto the A1 (approx. 9:35)

Turning left onto The Bishops Avenue

Turning left onto Deansway

Turning left onto Brim Hill

Turning right onto Ossulton Way

Turning left onto East End Road

Turning right onto Manor View

Along Manor View to Squires Lane.

Turning left onto Long Lane (approx. 9:50)

Turning left onto Ballards Lane

Along Ballards Lane to Regents Park Road Along Regents Park Road to Finchley Road

Turning left onto Addison Way (approx. 10:00)

Turning right onto Erskine Hill

Turning left onto North Square

Turning left onto Northway

Turning right onto Thornton Way

Turning right onto Southway


Turning left onto South Square
