SERVICE GUIDE FOR ROSH HASHANAH

We recognise that some of our members are ready to return to in-person gathering, while for others this is not yet possible.

Our High Holy Day programme reflects both of these needs, including a full online programme similar to last year, as well as a rolling programme of in-person services taking place at the Sternberg Centre.

We invite all Alyth members to create a journey through the High Holy Days that is right for you. You can find full details of all our Rosh Hashanah offerings in this booklet, as well as booking links for all in-person services across Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

Joining our High Holy Days from home

We will once again be offering a full programme online from Alyth, including offerings for the heart, soul, breath and mind. These services will include contributions from members from their homes. Teaching and meditation sessions over Zoom will be fully interactive, as we have come to expect over the past eighteen months.

The services in the marquee will be live-streamed from a static camera. You can join these services via Zoom.

On Rosh Hashanah, there will also be four in-person services, taking place at the Sternberg Centre:

RH1: Tuesday 7 September

- Abridged Choral Service in the High Holy Day marquee	(09:00-11:00)	
- Sensory Rosh Hashanah in the Akiva School Hall	(09:45-10:45)	
- Bio Bano in the High Holy Day marquee	(11:45-13:00)	

RH2: Wednesday 8 September

- Kollot with kids' corner and breakout in the High Holy Day marquee (10:30-13:00)

These services must be pre-booked. Your confirmation email will act as your ticket to allow entry.

In-person services will be familiar, but in some ways different to a "normal" year, reflecting the fact that Covid remains endemic in society and we have a responsibility for each others' well being. Services will be abridged, with no mitzvot or Torah procession.

Covid protocols will be in place, meaning that there will be a 50% cap on capacity to allow distancing. Marquee services will also be live-streamed from a static camera over Zoom.

MIND: MUSAF FOR THE MIND: THE POWER OF LAUGHTER (12:15)

The Days of Atonement are usually conceived as a serious and solemn time of the year, yet our Rosh Hashanah Torah readings mention laughter. The Hebrew name for the character of Isaac ('Yitzchak') translates as 'he will laugh', and in this morning's reading Sarah takes offence at Ishmael laughing. Join Rabbi Elliott for a Musaf break-out to consider the role of laughter in our Jewish lives, and reflect on why laughter is just as important as solemnity in our High Holy Days.

This session will also include the blowing of shofar.
