Clergy Jewish Participation Fund

The Clergy Jewish Participation Fund is set up to support Alyth members to lead full Jewish lives, enabling them to participate in Jewish programmes and activities that are run and organised by Alyth and other external organisations, without finance being a barrier to participation.

The Clergy Jewish Participation Fund supports members needing financial assistance to come to our Kindergarten, to go on Summer schemes and trips and weekends away, and to attend wider Jewish community conferences and events.

Over the past eighteen months there has been a reduction in the delivery of many schemes, learning opportunities and programmes. As we emerge from the pandemic, these activities will undoubtedly resume. This past Summer, our own and the Movement run Summer schemes and camps have gone ahead in a Covid-safe way. Enabling members of all ages to lead full, participative Jewish lives is a priority for us. With your support, the Clergy Jewish Participation Fund ensures that we are able to fulfil this obligation.

Alyth Community Care Fund

The Alyth Community Care Fund supports those who need dedicated support, activities and social interactions. It also funds welfare and wellbeing activities, and provides financial support at critical moments to those who need it most.

During the pandemic the fund was able to provide vital support services, pay for food and medical deliveries and help with the payment of bills at difficult times. The running costs of the Alyth minibus are covered by the fund, enabling us to use it for transporting members, dropping-off donations at food banks and for our Simchat Torah, Torah Tour.

Without the funds raised through the High Holy Days Appeal, the Community Care Fund would not be able to continue to fund the provision of social and cultural activities that enrich the lives of so many of our members and ensure that when members are ready to, they can come to Alyth to enjoy these activities and our regular services.
