FOUNDATIONS FOR THE FUTURE**LAYING THE FOUNDATIONS**

Once the foundations were dug, in and around the perimeter of the site, the next step was to pour the concrete and secure the bolts that will hold the steel frame in place. This work requires patience and precision. The Borrás Team have been brilliant and we continue to marvel at the skill of the man who is behind the wheel of the digger. He has a number of 'tools' that attach to the end of the machine, each able to do a specialist task - digging a wide or narrow trench, lifting, moving and removing, breaking down and even repairing, when needed.

It's not only the Kindergarten children who love a digger. All of us on site are enjoying watching too.

DIGGING DOWN AND BUILDING UP

Over the last three weeks, the focus has been on the foundations. First the foundations were mapped and dug out, creating a firm footing on which the steel structure that will hold up the building, can be fitted. The site looked a little like an archeological dig. Luckily nothing was found that might hold up the work over the coming weeks.
